Minimum qualifications for this position include a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or related human services field with at least 5 years of related experience providing treatment services to families and providing supervision. Master's Degree in social work or related human services field as well as professional experience providing treatment services to families and providing supervision is preferred. Strong counseling, management, and supervisory skills required. All appropriate licenses, registrations, and/or certifications are required. Any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this position may be considered. A valid KY driver's license and access to reliable transportation required.
